### 1,799 Families Served

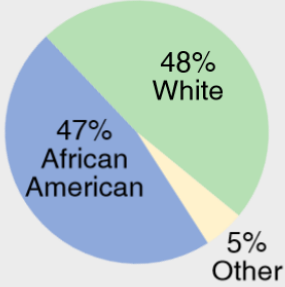
- ✓ 667 Pregnant Women

- ✓ 1,460 Children



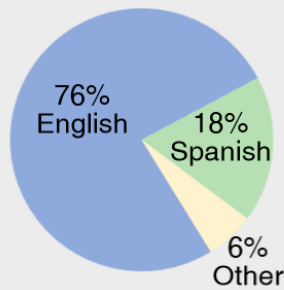
### Among the 819 Families Newly Enrolled this Year:

- 19% pregnant women under age 21
- 24% with history of child abuse or neglect
- 19% have a child with developmental delays or disabilities
- 20% with history of substance abuse

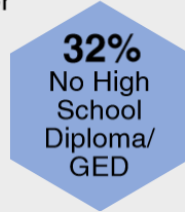
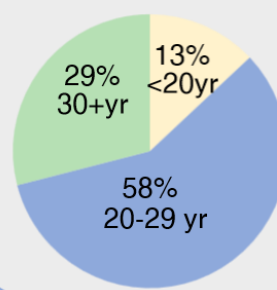
#### Race
